NEWSPAPER HIGHLIGHTS

- The Centre wrote to States suggesting options of borrowing money to make up the ₹• 2.35 lakh crore shortfall in GST revenues expected in the ongoing fiscal. the Finance **Ministry** wrote to Governments saying they could borrow either via a special it would facilitate window through the RBI, or raise debt from the market.
- In a departure from the past, the annual migration of butterflies from the hill ranges of the Eastern Ghats towards the Western Ghats is an early phenomenon this year. Change in rainfall pattern and a considerable increase in the number of sunny days could be among the reasons.
- Turkey said it will hold a military exercise off northwest Cyprus for the next two weeks, amid growing tension with Greece over disputed claims to exploration rights in the east Mediterranean.
- The Union government is all set to come out with an executive order to extend protection to land rights of domiciles in Jammu and Kashmir. The point of debate is currently on protection to be given to agricultural land.
- The Border Security Force (BSF) reported finding a tunnel along the Jammu-Pakistan border. several Pakistani terrorists infiltrated from the sector between the months of March to May in 2018, with high grade RDX explosives that were used to assemble 200 kilogramme bomb deployed in the Pulwama attack.
- A group of 40 scientists, environmentalists and ecologists have written to Prime Minister Narendra Modi demanding a halt to the Char Dham road construction work and that the recommendation of environmentalist Ravi Chopra, who heads a Supreme Court appointed committee to advise on the sustainable execution of the project, be heeded.

HUMAN AFRICAN TRYPANOSOMIASIS OR SLEEPING SICKNESS

- 1. Recently, Togo has become the first country in Africa to eliminate this disease.
- 2. Togo is a western Africa country, **bordering**Ghana, Benin and Burkina Faso. It extends south to the Gulf of Guinea.
- **3.** It is a widespread tropical disease which spread by the bite of an infected **tsetse fly(Glossina Genus)**, a species native to the African continent.

EASE OF DOING BUSINESS(EODB) REPORT

- 1. It is an index published by the World Bank(WB).

 Recently, WB reported irregularities in the data used to prepare EODB ranking.
- **2.** It encourages economies to compete towards more efficient regulation; offers measurable benchmarks for reform; and serves as a resource for academics, journalists, private sector researchers and others interested in the business climate of each economy.
- India has moved 14 places to be 63rd among 190 nations in the World Bank's EODB ranking 2020.

PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE(PMO) EXPLORES COMMON VOTER LIST FOR LOK SABHA, STATE AND LOCAL POLLS

- In many states, voters` list for panchayat and municipality elections is different from one used for Parliament and Assembly elections.
- **2.** The distinction is because the conduct of elections is entrusted to two different constitutional bodies.
- **3.** Benefit of Common electoral list- **Saves Duplication of effort and expenditure**; Reduces confusion for voters as they may find their names present in one roll, but absent in another.
