NEWSPAPER HIGHLIGHTS

- With individual donations and corporate contributions drying up amid the coronavirus pandemic and the lockdown, an institution (National Association of Blind) that has supported the education of visually impaired children in Delhi for decades is on its last legs.
- Pakistan offers to reopen Kartarpur on 29th June,India says short notice.Pandemic halted travel,Pak trying to create mirage of goodwill:Indian Officials.
- Mumbai has started reporting symptoms similar to Kawasaki disease(inflammation in the walls of some blood vessels in the body) among young patients with COVID-19.
- China will have to pay a "heavyprice" for decades for resorting to aggressive military behaviour towards India in eastern Ladakh as it will isolate the country globally, strategic affairs experts said.
- The Jammu and Kashmir administration issued domicile certificates to more than 50 Bangladesh refugees as well as members of the Balmiki and Gorkha communities who have long been living in the region but were not eligible for full citizenship rights under the erstwhile state's laws.
- The centre issued revised clinical management protocols for Covid-19 treatment of patients, including the low-cost anti-inflammatory drug Dexamethasone as an alternative another steroid, Methylprednisolone, for moderate to severe cases.
- The high-level Group of Ministers (GoM) held its seventeenth meeting on the current status of Covid-19 cases in the country. It was highlighted that eight states—Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Delhi, Telangana, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal—contribute 85.5 per cent of the active caseload and 87 per cent of the total deaths in India.
- Sri Lanka's request to India for a postponement of its debt repayment amid the current economic crisis is under consideration, No decision four months on despite a request to PM.
