NEWSPAPER HIGHLIGHTS

- Speaking at the United Nation's 75th anniversary commemoration, Secretary-General António Guterres said the world had a surplus of multilateral challenges but not enough multilateral answers to these.
- An unchecked digital media is capable of spreading "venomous hatred," terror and violence, In fact, the digital media has already done all of this,the Centre told the Supreme Court.
- In the earliest announcement of minimum support prices, Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar told the Lok Sabha that the Cabinet had approved MSP hikes for six crops, including a 2.6% increase in the rate for wheat.
- The Rajya Sabha suspended eight Opposition MPs for their "unruly" behaviour during the debate and voting on two farm sector Bills.
- Sub Lt. Kumudini Tyagi and Sub Lt. Riti Singh will be the first women airborne tacticians (combatants) in the country who will operate from the deck of warships.
- The Centre informed the Rajya Sabha that due to some limitations, collating national data on the causes of farmers' suicides was untenable.
- Sixth round of Corps Commander level talks between Indian and China aimed at ending the five month long standoff along the disputed boundary in Ladakh.
- A woman fighter pilot is expected to soon join the No. 17 Golden Arrows squadron of the Indian Air Force (IAF) flying the recently inducted Rafale fighter jets, a defence source said.
- China ramped up its rhetoric over Taiwan, describing any support for its independence as "doomed to fail", and threatened retaliation against U.S. diplomatic visits to the island.

KOMODO DRAGONS

- 1. Recent study shows that komodo dragons, world's largest lizards could soon go extinct.
- 2. IUCN status: Vulnerable and trade is prohibited under CITES.
- **3.** Habitat-It occurs on **Komodo island** and a few neighbouring islands of the Lesser Sunda islands of Indonesia.
- **4.** Threats-Habitat loss due to Climate change and poaching.

WHAT IS SPICe+

- 1. It is an integrated web form offering 10 services by 3 central Govt. Ministeries & Departments(Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Ministry of Labour & Department of Revenue) and One State Government.
- 2. It was introduced as a part of Government's Ease of Doing Business initiatives.
- **3.** It helps by saving procedures, time and cost for starting a Business.

e-GRAMSWARAJ PORTAL

- **1.** Ministry of Panchayati Raj has launched this portal to strengthen e-Governance in Panchayati Raj Institutions across the country.
- It aims to bring in better transparency in the decentralised planning, progress reporting and workbased accounting.
- **3.** It provides a single window for capturing Panchayat Information with the complete Profile of the Panchayat,details of Panchayat finances,asset details,activities taken up through Gram Panchayat Development Plan(GRDP) etc.

FIFTEENTH FINANCE COMMISSION(FFC) IN ITS REPORT FOR 2020-21 RECOMMENDED GRANTS FOR RURAL LOCAL BODIES(RLBs)

- 1. Grants have been recommended for all tiers of the Panchayati Raj and also to the fifth and Sixth schedule areas.
- 2. Total size of the grants is Rs.60,750 crore in 2020-21.
- **3.** Grants are provided in two parts:50% are Basic Grants that are untied and can be used for location-specific felt needs, except for salary or other establishment expenditure.
- **4.** 50% as Tied Grant to be used for basic services of sanitation and maintenance of open-defecation free status and supply of drinking water.

FELUDA TEST

- 1. It is a low-cost, paper-based test strip to detect COVID-19 in less than 30 minutes.
- **2.** It is developed by Council of Scientific and Industrial Research-Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology and Tata Group.

MEMORY OF UNDERSTANDING(MoU) SIGNED BETWEEN MINISTRY OF AYUSH AND MoWCD FOR CONTROLLING MALNUTRITION
