#### **NEWSPAPER HIGHLIGHTS**

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI)
  has constituted a working group
  on digital lending including
  online platforms and mobile
  apps to study all aspects of
  digital lending activities in the
  regulated financial sector as
  well as by unregulated players.
- The Supreme Court took suo cognisance motu of contamination of rivers by sewage effluents through lapses committed by municipalities, saying "open surface water resources including rivers are lifeline  $\mathbf{of}$ the human civilisation".
- OTT (OverTheTop) platforms such as Netflix, Amazon Prime and others need to be regulated, Chairman of the Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC), Prasoon Joshi, said at a meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Information and Technology.
- In the biggest indigenous defence deal, the Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) approved the manufacture of 83 Tejas light combat aircraft (LCA) by HAL for the Indian Air Force (IAF).
- The Agriculture Ministry has denied RTI request for details on prelegislative consultations on the farm reform laws, saying the matter is sub judice.
- The Union Health Ministry has postponed the polio immunisation drive scheduled from January 17.
- In his government's first admission yet of Indian involvement in developing a container terminal at the strategically coveted Colombo Port, President Gotabaya Rajapaksa said 49% of the investment will come from the "Adani Group.
- The Supreme Court on Wednesday admitted a petition filed by the Ministry of Defence (MoD) seeking to exempt armed forces personnel from the ambit of a Constitution Bench judgment of 2018 that decriminalised adultery.

#### 2D-ELECTRON GAS(2DEG)

- **1.**Produced by-Institute of Nano-Science and Technology(INST), an autonomous institution of Department of Science and Technology.
- 2.2DEG is an electron gas with ultra-high mobility, which can speed up transfer of quantum information and signal from one part of a device to another and increase data storage and memory.
- **3.**Strong spin-orbit coupling and relativistic nature of the electrons in the 2DEG resulted in Rashba field.
- **4.**Rashba effect consists of splitting of spin-bands in an electronic system, might play a key role in spintronic devices.

#### FIVE YEARS OF PRADHAN MANTRI FASAL BIMA YOJANA

- 1. The flagship crop insurance scheme of the Government of India the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) has completed five years of its launch. It provides a comprehensive insurance cover against failure of the crop thus helping in stabilising the income of the farmers.
- **2.The Scheme covers over 5.5 crore farmer applications on average per year. Aadhar seeding** (linking Aadhaar through Internet banking portals) has helped in speedy claim settlement directly into the farmer accounts.
- **3.**One notable example is mid-season adversity claims of nearly Rs. 30 crore in Rajasthan during Rabi 2019-20 Locust attack.

#### ASIAN HOUBARA BUSTARD

- **1.**The Pakistan government has issued special permits to Dubai royal family members, allowing them to hunt the internationally protected bird houbara bustard during the 2020-21 hunting season.
- **2.**Bustards are large, terrestrial birds that belong to several species, including some of the largest flying birds.
- **3.**The population of the Asian houbara bustards extends from northeast Asia, across central Asia, the Middle East, and the Arabian Peninsula to reach the Sinai desert (Egypt).

### KAYAKALP AWARDS

- **1.**Tthe Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has conferred 5th National Kayakalp awards to Public and Private Health Facilities for high standards of Sanitation and Hygiene.
- 2.Those District Hospitals, Sub-divisional hospitals, Community Health Centres, Primary Health Centres and Health & Wellness Centres in the public healthcare system who have achieved high levels of cleanliness, hygiene and infection control were recognised and felicitated with awards.

# SCANDALISING THE COURTS:A GROUND FOR CONTEMPT

- 1. The Karnataka High Court has issued notice to the Union government on a PIL petition, challenging the constitutional validity of a provision of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, that makes "scandalising or tends to scandalising courts" as a ground for contempt.
- **2.**Public Interest Litigation (PIL) stands for a legal action taken by a public spirited person in order to protect public interest (any act for the benefit of the public).
- **3.**Contempt is the power of the court to protect its own majesty and respect. The power is regulated but not restricted in the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
